What is Fix It?



Fix It

is a multi-craft trades program designed to provide training for income-

eligible youth who are no longer in school and between the ages of out-of-school youth ages 17-24. The program encourages women, as well as English as a Second Language (ESL) individuals, to participate.

The lengths of each course range from 5 to 25 weeks, six hours per day, Monday-Friday. After the successful completion of the required core, participants can choose from a variety of construction-related and auto-body programs. Participants can also earn a GED, if needed.

After completing the initial 5-week core course, participants must pass a drug test before being allowed to enter the next phase of training.

Upon acceptance to the next phase of training - NCCER and Auto Body, participants will receive \$300 towards tools and a stipend of \$20 per day.

ACT WorkKeys

Trade orientation will consist of academic assessments through WorkKeys where the participants will receive the National Career Readiness Certificate (NCRC).

NCCER Courses

Participants who choose to study **carpentry, painting, plumbing,** or **electrical** will receive the National Center for Construction Education and Research (NCCER) Level 1 certificate. Each course is less than 6 weeks to complete.

I-CAR Course

Participants who choose to study auto body repair will receive an International Center for Automotive Research (I-CAR) certificate. This program lasts 25 weeks.
