We have also set up a drop box within the Public Safety Department (next door, same building) for filings, payments, or other correspondence. We will only take payments in check or money order form. Do not place cash in the drop box. You may also call the Court if you have questions at (251) 368-9136 ext. 2660 Monday through Friday 8:00 a.m. through 5:00 p.m. Most in-person court proceedings, including Wellness (Drug) Court, have been suspended until further notice. We are, however, continuing Wellness (Drug) Court hearings through conference calls with our participants. Probation and Wellness (Drug) Court Participants will be contacted individually with instructions as necessary. Any emergency cases will be heard, and these cases will be handled at the discretion of the Judge. We will notify all parties with a notice of appearance if necessary.
