Military


Penn Foster High School graduates who score 50 or higher on the Armed Forces Qualification Test (AFQT) will receive Tier 1 enlistment priority.*





Pricing

- Penn Foster offers a variety of tuition payment options to fit your budget.

Transfer Credits

We are able to accept up to **16 credits** from your previous high school upon an evaluation of your official sealed transcript and we will reduce your tuition by **\$35** for each credit that transfer in. The amount of credits Penn Foster accepts depends on a few variables up to and including:

- The School in which credits are being transferred from must be Regionally accredited however, in some situations we will require standardized test scores (i.e.: homeschooled students).
- Credit ratios (Some states/locales require more credits to graduate so we complete a class to class transfer)
- Types of courses (The courses being transferred in must be comparable to Penn Foster's curriculum)
- Grades (You must have earned a D or above (and/or 65 and above) for classes to be eligible for transfer credit)
- Half credits cannot transfer alone (We will do our best to match half credits to equal a full credit)


