What is a Mosquito Dunk?

A mosquito dunk is a biological pesticide that kills mosquito larvae that live in stagnant water for up to 30 days. The dunks are safe for the environment, and safe to use around animals. They are easy to use and can be purchases at most garden or home improvement stores.

Where to use Mosquito Dunks?

- Flower Pots
- Bird Baths
- Tires
- Unused Swimming Pools
- Animal Watering Troughs
- Drainage Ditches
- Tree Holes
- Unused Boats and Tarps

Any place that collects and holds standing water!

How to Prevent Mosquitoes?

Eliminate standing water in rain gutters, old tires, buckets, plastic covers, toys or any other container where pests can breed.

Empty and change the water in bird baths, fountains, wading pools, rain barrels and potted plant trays at least once per week to destroy potential habitats.
