## NORTHEASTERN STATE UNIVERISTY TRIBAL HERITAGE SCHOLARSHIP

This scholarship program has been designed to assist in funding undergraduate American Indian students' education at Northeastern State University. Those students eligible for the program will receive a tuition waiver scholarship for 100% of their non-resident tuition.

Undergraduate non-resident tuition is an additional \$269 per hour enrolled for the 2018-19 academic year.

## **Eligibility Requirements:**

- 1. Non-resident of the state of Oklahoma
- 2. Must meet **regular admission requirements** as an incoming freshmen or transfer student (students alternatively admitted are *not* eligible)
- 3. Must be enrolled full-time (at least 12 hours) at NSU
- 4. Must possess a tribal citizenship card from a federally recognized tribe

A copy of your tribal citizenship card will be required to complete your scholarship application if you choose to apply for funding from this program.
