## 2020 CENSUS STARTS APRIL 1, 2020

The Poarch Band of Creek Indians has worked hard for federal recognition and representation. The federal government and American Indian leaders and decision-makers will use 2020 Census data in a variety of ways that can benefit our community directly.

### IT'S EASY.

In mid-March 2020, every household in the United States will receive a notice to complete the census online, by phone, or by mail.

### IT'S SAFE.

Your responses to the 2020 Census are confidential and protected by law. Personal information is never shared with any other government agencies or law enforcement, including federal, local, and tribal authorities.

7. What is this person's race?  
Mark  one or more boxes AND print origins.

White – Print, for example, German, Irish, English, Italian, Lebanese, Egyptian, etc. ↴

Black or African Am. – Print, for example, African American, Jamaican, Haitian, Nigerian, Ethiopian, Somali, etc. ↴

American Indian or Alaska Native – Print name of enrolled or principal tribe(s), for example, Navajo Nation, Blackfeet Tribe, Mayan, Aztec, Native Village of Barrow Inupiat Traditional Government, Nome Eskimo Community, etc. ↴

Asian Indian       Japanese       Chamorro

Other Asian – Print, for example, Pakistani, Cambodian, Hmong, etc. ↴

Other Pacific Islander – Print, for example, Tongan, Fijian, Marshallese, etc. ↴

Some other race – Print race or origin. ↴

## QUESTION 7

Question 7 of the 2020 Census will ask for your race. PCI Tribal Government encourages our Tribal Members to mark the 'American Indian or Alaska Native' box, then write 'Poarch Band of Creek Indians' in the space provided, as demonstrated below.

The words 'Poarch Band of Creek Indians' will not fit in the space provided. Make sure you write the remaining letters down the right side of the form, clearly and legibly. Failure to follow these instructions may void your submission.
