Have an interest in health care with a desire to return to rural Alabama

Selection

Participants are selected based on their interests, motivation and personal qualities most suited for becoming future

physicians and other health professionals in a rural community. For this reason, applicants are asked for at least two

letters of recommendation from individuals familiar with the student's academic record.
