This is a 3-semester full time program that will have modules in Carpentry, HVAC, Electricity, Masonry and Plumbing. These individuals can then gain employment as Maintenance Technicians with NCCER certifications.

This program will run 8 weeks and prepare students to become Certified Nursing Assistants. This is a limited-entry program. Grant funding available for those who qualify.
