



NO MATTER WHO YOU ARE, AN HIV (AIDS) TEST IS FOR YOU..

There is not a cure. But antiretroviral therapy (ART) can dramatically prolong the lives of many people infected with HIV and lower the chance of infecting others. It is important to get tested and know your HIV status so that you can protect yourself and others by starting treatment.

The Primary Care Clinic will be offering HIV Screening to patients ages 13 to 64 beginning May 2, 2016. All screening will remain confidential. Call today to make an appointment.

- The only way to know if you are infected with HIV is to be tested.**
- Many people who are infected with HIV do not have any symptoms at all for 10 years or more.**
- You can be screened with a simple blood test and know your results in 30 minutes.**
- Today, someone diagnosed with HIV and treated before the disease is far advanced can have a nearly normal life span.**
