NOTICE OF PROGRAM CHANGES

The following changes have been made to the Drug and Alcohol Testing Policy for Tribally Sponsored Programs:

THE PROGRAM HAS BEEN RENAMED TO DRUG AND ALCOHOL TESTING POLICY FOR TRIBALLY SPONSORED PROGRAMS.

Tribal Court will be the required testing site for any participant who lives within a 200 mile radius (roundtrip) of the reservation.

An emergency is defined as a serious, unexpected and often dangerous situation requiring immediate action to protect life, health and property.



The program now includes alcohol testing for minors!



- * Tribal Attendance Officer will make three (3) attempts within a 24 hour period to set up the drug test.
- * Participant's drug test is good for ninety (90) days if negative.
- * Alcohol is considered an illegal drug for participants under the age of 21 and will result in a failed test.
- * The first time the participant is reported as a failure to test or has a positive test the participant is ineligible to participate in any Tribally Sponsored Program for a period of 180 days. The second time the participant is reported as a failure to test or has a positive test the participant will be terminated from participation in any Tribally Sponsored Program for a period of 365 days.
- * Tribally sponsored programs now include Torch Club & Keystone Club
