

JACK KENT COOKE FOUNDATION UNDERGRADUATE TRANSFER SCHOLARSHIP

The Jack Kent Cooke Foundation Undergraduate Transfer Scholarship makes it possible for the nation's top community college students to complete their bachelor's degrees by transferring to a selective four-year college or university. The Foundation provides up to \$40,000 per year to each of approximately 55 deserving students selected annually, making it the largest private scholarship for two-year and community college transfer students in the country. A minimum 3.5 GPA is required as well as demonstrated unmet financial need. Students must be a current student at an accredited U.S. community college or two-year institution with sophomore status or a recent graduate.
