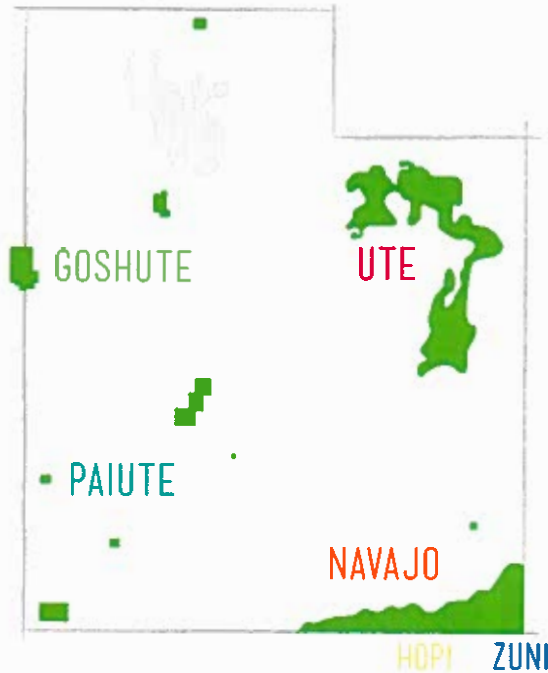
**UVU** NATIVE AMERICAN INITIATIVE

Utah Valley University is located in Orem, Utah. The university's unique Open Admission policy allows the institution to accept anyone with a high school diploma or its equivalent.

Utah State Board of Regents allows the following tribes to qualify for resident status, as long as students are able to provide Certificates of Indian Blood:

Other tribes have the possibility of resident status after one year.

Native American advisors assist with admissions, registration, scholarships, and financial aid. UVU has an inner network of Native American mentors and staff to help students succeed.



UVU's Native American Club, the Native Wolverine Association, provide opportunities to get involved with Native American programs and events. The club is very active in the community, educating the area's residents about Native culture and traditions.



UVU offers 73 bachelor degrees, 63 associate degrees, and 35 certificate programs. UVU also has eight master's degree programs in accountancy, business administration, computer science, cybersecurity, education, nursing, public service, and social work.
