

ABUSE PREVENTION PROGRAM

The Abuse Prevention Program provides intervention services to victims of:

- » Domestic Violence**
- » Family Violence**
- » Dating Violence**
- » Sexual Assault**
- » Stalking**

Family Services maintains an Emergency Shelter to provide time-limited shelter (usually 72 hours) for these victims. Any extensions of stay must be approved by the Family Services Director. Even though the shelter is used primarily for victims of domestic violence and/or child abuse, it may also be used for people in other types of emergency situations.

Each occupant over eighteen (18) years of age must pass a criminal background check in order to stay at the shelter.

A time-limited transitional housing program is available for victims on a time-limited basis per their individualized case plan.
