

ADULT SERVICES PROGRAM

The Adult Services Program provides assistance to adult PCI Tribal Members and their families.

This can include assistance with:

- » General Welfare Issues
- » Family Issues
- » Adult Abuse and Neglect Investigations
- » Protective Services

The Adult Services Program administers three in-home programs:

- » Homemaker Case Aide Program
- » Attendant Care Program
- » Assisted Living Care

Homemaker Aide Program:

- » Provides direct homemaker aide services to elderly and/or disabled Tribal Members who reside within the Tribe's service area.
- » Short-term in-home assisted living services:
 - > General Cleaning
 - > Meal Preparation and Planning
 - > Grocery Shopping
 - > Assistance with transportation to medical appointments through arrangements with the PCI Health Department

Attendant Care Program:

- » Provides in-home services for members of PCI Tribal Member households who require twenty-four (24) hour care
- » Time-limited in-home services for the PCI Tribal Member household resident who is bed-ridden or has late-stage Alzheimer's or Dementia and requires twenty-four (24) hour care

Assisted Living Care:

- » Provides assistance with payment to placement in the Lavan Marton Assisted Living Facility or a licensed Assisted Living Facility of his/her choice.

Cases are assessed by medical referrals and documentation, as well as meeting program criteria.
