## POARCH CREEK FIRE DEPARTMENT

### FOOD TRUCK/ MOBILE CONCESSIONS

Due to the inherent dangers of cooking in mobile concessions, not only to the occupants but also to the public at large, a Fire and Life Safety Inspection by Poarch Creek Fire Department is required prior to public events located on the campus.

Mobile concessions (food trucks/trailers) that fry and/or create heat and grease laden vapors (as per International Fire Code 607 and the International Mechanical Code 304) shall provide the following:

#### Applicable permits:

- Escambia County, Alabama Health Department or Poarch Creek Environmental Inspection
- Business License from the City of Business Location
- Poarch Creek Fire (Annual Food Truck Inspection)

#### Annual Certifications:

- Commercial Kitchen Hood (Annual) Inspection Tag.
- Portable fire extinguisher, minimum 2A:10BC (Annual) Inspection Tag
- Class "K" extinguisher (Annual) Inspection Tag

Other conditions to monitor will include visual inspection of power cords and outlets, cleanliness of the unit and cooking equipment, evidence of grease/grime on the outer shell, and unobstructed path to the exit.

Where fuel tanks are stored outside the shell, they shall be properly secured and protected.

Exit pathways shall not be diminished or obstructed in any way by placement of the vehicle and/or associated equipment.

This inspection will not apply to those vendors providing cold items such as ice cream, sandwiches, snacks and drinks. A fire extinguisher will be required (minimum 2A: 10BC (Annual) Inspection Tag).
